(ISC)² Chapters offer opportunities to earn CPEs. As an approved CPE submitter, (ISC)² Chapters submit CPEs on behalf of its members to (ISC)² for attending chapter-related and eligible activities that focus on topics related to cyber, information, software and infrastructure security.





Education (CPEs)



The basic requirements to start an (ISC)² Chapter:

- (ISC)² credential holders in good standing for at least three years.
- Petitioner must reside in the location of interest for at least one year.
- A minimum of 15 (ISC)² members are required to sign the application.
- Must have professional leadership experience.
- Not currently serving as an officer of another security chapter organization.
- No previous convictions of criminal activity or conduct.
